In 6th grade language arts we had the students identify tone and mood in Remember the Titans and it is what we are using during our enrichment time to reinforce this difficult concept. Students were asked to look at a poem and determine its mood and tone and then had to rewrite it to change the tone and mood by identifying key words that would change it.

During enrichment, we have taken it a step further and have asked students to read "The Monkey's Paw" and identify the mood and tone as dark and scary. In small groups, students were charged to rewrite it to change to mood and tone for an appropriate children's book you would read to a younger sibling at bedtime.

The students have really enjoyed rewriting things to change its tone and mood. Making these difficult concepts relevant and tangible for them has enhanced their understanding.
